Point # 1

This year many Christians came to the booth who were excited about what we were doing. Not only I, but other laborers at the booth told these Christians to start telling others about Jesus. Jesus is the Rock that gave water in the desert, Numbers 20:8. I asked a young couple that if they had found water in the desert, wouldn't they want to share it with others.
