Gospel Presentation Policy

The leadership of FGBMFA of the North Texas Region is in agreement on the following policy points as it relates to the high holy privilege we have been given to present the gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and the methods used to facilitate such presentation at the State Fair of Texas Gospel Outreach.

Key Scriptures

- **1 Thessalonians 2:4** - We are approved by God the Father to be entrusted with the gospel...He tests our hearts with the gospel.
- HOW do we get approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel:
- The answer is found in **2 Timothy 2:15 & 3:14-17** where it says that gospel workers need to be diligent (or study) to present themselves approved to You; workers who need not be ashamed but who rightly divide the word of truth and who continue in the things which they've learned and been assured of...those who know the holy scriptures which are given by God for profiting us that we, as sons of God, would be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- **1 Peter 3:15** says we are to always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks for a reason for the hope that is in you.

Policy Points

1. It's all about study, diligence, effort, hard work, preparation, being ready, prayer, fasting even!
2. Know what the Bible says about the gospel. Be filled with the Word and led by the Spirit.
3. Just show up and watch is a good entrée.
4. Be ready with your testimony....then tell what you know about Jesus.
5. KNOW The Million Dollar Eye Test tract...it contains all the elements of the gospel plus great apologetics!
6. It is recommended that you spend 30 minutes a day for at least 30 days reviewing the contents of this tract prior to your day of service at the Fair.
7. Pages 1 thru 8 are the most important pages and deserve the biggest investment of your time.
8. We do not want you to memorize the tract or to read it to people. We want you to study the tract and the related scriptures and to have them deposited in your heart so the Holy Spirit can bring them out of your heart as He sees fit and lead you to deliver them to the hearers He sends your way in a conversational, relational, eyeball-to-eyeball manner.
9. Each person He sends to you on your day of service at the Fair will likely need to hear it in a different way.
